[Extract of the statutes of the Association]

The purpose of the European Animation Awards Association is to hold an annual vote directed to reward the best European animated work and its professionals that have distinguished themselves the year prior.

The Association is comprised of Active, Associated and Honorary Members.

Are allowed to take part in the vote the Active & Associated members of the Association that have joined the Association during the civil year of the ceremony.

Active members are natural or legal persons particularly interested in the accomplishment of the objectives of the Association. Associated members support the Association through their memberships and participate in the yearly vote for the Awards. The Associated Members may attend the General Assembly but without holding voting rights.

Natural and Legal persons wishing to join the Association have to reside in a European Country and/ or assume their professional activity in said country.

The Association aims at gathering the whole of European Animation professional industry to celebrate its achievements.
